CIVIC AND CHARITIES' LUNCHEON - Trinity House TUESDAY 19TH JUNE 2018

The Master is pleased to confirm details for the Civic and Charities' Luncheon with again a focus on some of the Charities that we support on a regular basis. On this occasion we shall be dining in the splendid surroundings of Trinity House.

Our guest speaker representing the Civic City will be Sheriff Neil Redcliffe JP, one of the two Sheriffs of the City of London. Neil is interested in the Business City as well as the Civic City.

At the request of some members, we are suggesting that for those who have it, Morning Dress should be worn.

Trinity House has been a leader in maritime safety and navigation since 1514. On 20 May 1514, a Royal Charter was presented to The Master, Wardens and Assistants of the Guild, Fraternity or Brotherhood of the Most Glorious and Undivided Trinity and of Saint Clement in the Parish of Deptford Strond, in the County of Kent, the Corporation's full name to this day. The current Master is HRH Princess Anne

Trinity House is a Grade 1 listed building. It was constructed in the years 1794-96 by Samuel Wyatt, Surveyor to the Corporation and brother of the famous James; Prime Minister William Pitt the Younger laid the foundation stone on 12 September 1793, and the first Court inside the new building was on 23 May 1796. It was gutted in 1940 when a German incendiary bomb lodged in the roof of the stairwell, leaving nothing of the original building save the Trinity Square facade. Professor (later Sir) Albert E Richardson undertook the reconstruction of the house by using a number of photographs of the rooms, taken by Country Life magazine in 1919, to reconstitute almost exactly the interior in its original form. It was refurbished and redecorated in March 1990; the redecoration is, where possible, in keeping with the 1790s.

As you might expect the Hall is used frequently by the Worshipful Company of Shipwrights for their dinners.

As the focus of the event is towards charity, we shall be presenting cheques to the various organisations and causes we support.
