Nowhere is this more apt than North East Hampshire, where we will meet at The National Trust property called The Vyne, Sherborne St John, to see the carefully landscaped gardens and the interiors of this 16th Century Stately Home. As many members of the company are National Trust members it is assumed that members will enter the Vyne without the need for purchasing a ticket but if you need a ticket for either the house or gardens they can be purchased on the day, at £13/head, available at the entrance. To view the house please book a time at the ticket office, on the day – we cannot, regrettably go as one group.

There is a coffee shop for a light lunch or if you require more substantial food then a nearby pub which provides locally sourced produce is The Wellington Arms, Baughurst. No bookings have been made and members will settle their own lunch costs.

We will re-convene, in Black Tie, at former National Trust Premises, West Green House, Hartley Wintney for Johann Strauss's opera Die Fledermaus – inspired by the glamour of Belle Epoque Vienna. There will be bubbles on arrival followed by a comprehensive picnic, including wine and the best available seat and a programme for the performance. The gardens at West Green House are justly famous and ably demonstrate the sheer skill a gardener can bring to humble earth. One folly in particular seems to resonate with our company, as it has as its inscription "this monument was built with a great deal of money, which otherwise someday would have been given into the hands of the public revenue". A sentiment all tax professionals can appreciate, from both perspectives!

On Sunday we will take Holy Communion at Grade 1 Listed Mattingley Church and then it is time for a hearty Hog Roast, as my guests, at Money's Farm, Mattingley completed with a farm walk to view the animals and semi-natural ancient woodland. The day should be completed by 3pm.
