VISIT TO THE THAMES POLICE MUSEUM

FRIDAY 13TH APRIL 2018

The Thames River Police Museum is located at Wapping Police Station. Situated within the headquarters of the Metropolitan Police's Marine Police Unit, the Museum offers visitors a unique insight into the history of the World's first police force.

Exhibits include uniforms and documents, which trace the history of the Thames River Police from its inception in 1798 to the present day. There is also a fine collection of the every day "Hardware" of policing from handcuffs to cutlasses.

The visit will be conducted by a retired serving officer with many years' experience of policing the river. Visits usually take about 2 hours which will give us plenty of time to hear the stories, ask questions and view the collection.

The party is restricted to 15 people and this will be strictly enforced. Early booking is advised.

We will meet at Wapping overground station at 3.45pm. If the trip proves popular then we will arrange further visits at a later date. Please note that as the buildings are early Victorian, we have been advised that there are accessibility issues in the museum building and also steep stairs to leave the platform at Wapping station.

Afterwards we have booked a window table overlooking the River Thames at the restaurant in the nearby Captain Kidd pub for supper.

The cost of the event will be £16.00 per person - £6 inclusive of VAT to cover our costs, plus an optional donation of £10 to the police charities. Supper at the Captain Kidd is on a self pay basis on the night. If you wish to attend, please complete the slip below and return as indicated.
