UK Data Protection Act

All data is securely stored in the Company's Database (held by the Clerk, Administrator and Webmaster) and in databases under the control of the Chartered Institute of Taxation (acting as the Company's agent). All data will be treated confidentially and with sensitivity for the benefit of the Worshipful Company of Tax Advisers and its members. The data is available to the Company's Court and Officers in connection with their duties under the Constitution and Ordinances.
